<Overview of Geothermal Resources Survey>

- Survey area: The Esan district of Hakodate in Hokkaido
- Survey details:
 - 1. Well drilling: Drilling of a well for identifying the volume of geothermal resources
 - 2. Geological survey of the shaft: Analyzing and examining geological features of the drilled soil
 - 3. Geophysical logging: Different measurements and testing for identifying characteristics of the well
 - 4. Overall geological analysis: Estimating the volume of geothermal resources from the findings obtained to draw up a future development plan
 - 5. Monitoring: Measuring components in vicinal thermal springs and rivers (continued from fiscal year 2015)
