We decided to have all employees working at the head office work at home from March 26 with the aim of preventing the spread of the new coronavirus (COVID-19) infection, in response to the Tokyo Governor's request on March 25.

We have decided to extend the period until May 6, in response to a state of emergency which the Japanese Government declared on April 7.

Our power plants are operating as usual while avoiding "Closed spaces" "Crowded places" "Close-contact settings". We will also closely monitor the situation, the government's decision and administrative policies so that we will be able to respond quickly and appropriately.
